PERFORMANCE NOTES

Although an abundance of doubling and cueing of parts has been written into this arrangement, it would be best to have as full a group as possible for performance, particularly in the brass parts. Note that the organ part could be considered optional. The vocal line is also optional, and may be used by any combination of vocals including a solo vocalist, praise team, choir, and/or congregation.

The piece begins with a duet for trumpets in which each phrase is echoed by the other part. This section may be performed in any of the following ways:

1. Simply have the 1st and 2nd trumpeters play the parts from their seated position on stage.
2. Have the 1st and 2nd trumpeters play the opening section from an antiphonal position. They then have 17 measures in which to walk back to their position on stage before they are required to play again.
3. If five or more trumpeters are present, use the optional antiphonal trumpet parts. The antiphonal parts play on the opening section (during which the on-stage 1st and 2nd players should tacet) and re-enter at measure 65 (still from the antiphonal position), ending at 80.

The preferred antiphonal position would be either in a balcony or in the back or the side of the auditorium, with one player on one side and one on the other, in order to accentuate the stereophonic nature of the parts. If this is not possible, the players could play on either side of the stage. Experiment to see what works best in your situation!
